About the device

1.1. What is the DALI XC



The DALI XC is a device with four inputs for controlling lighting with single momentary-action switches, double momentary-action switches and standard switches, which can be combined in some operating modes.

The DALI XC is supplied by the DALI control line. For this reason, a device that provides the voltage is required for use in a lighting system (e.g. DALI PS3). The DALI XC combines all the functions of the previous models "DALI MC", "DALI GC/-A" & "DALI SC/-A" and therefore creates a higher flexibility with the configuration and control of a DALI line.




2.1. Mode selection



The device has seven operating modes. These are indicated by the letters A to G.

The operating mode is configured via the **rotary selector switch "Mode"**. If the rotary selector switch is set to a non-marked position, the DALI XC has no function.

2.2. Configuration of scenes and groups



Depending on the selected operating mode, the connected switches can be assigned to different groups or scenes. The configuration of scenes and groups is done via the **rotary selector switch "Config"**. The selector has 15 positions.

2.3. Acoustic feedback

Some actions on the DALI XC produce a different number of high beep sounds. During the configuration, these beep sounds indicate that partial steps have been reached.

3.1. "Mode A: MC"

In "Mode A: MC" previously programmed functions can be called up via single momentary-action switches and/or double momentary-action switches and/or standard switches.

By default, the device has no functions in "MC" operating mode. But functions can be programmed via the masterCONFIGURATOR software (with version V2.10 or newer).

The rotary selector switch "Config" has no function in "Mode A: MC".

3.2. "Mode B: SC-A"

In "Mode B: SC-A" different scenes can be called via momentary-action switches.

Which scene is called by which switch can be set via the rotary selector switch "Config".

Also see table Assignment of switches to scenes, S. 9.

3.3. "Mode C: SC"

In "Mode C: SC" different scenes can be called and saved via momentary-action switches.

Which scene is called by which switch can be set via the rotary selector switch "Config". Steps for saving scenes in "Mode C: SC" are explained in the user manual of the DALI XC.

After the configuration, it is recommended to set the mode to "SC-A". Otherwise, saved scenes could be overwritten by other users.

3.4. "Mode D: GC-A"

In "Mode D: GC-A" luminaire groups can be switched ON/OFF or dimmed up and down via single momentary-action switches and/or double momentary-action switches.

The programming mode cannot be enabled. If the lighting system is switched to programming mode using another DALI XC device, the momentary-action switches connected to the DALI XC in "GC-A" operating mode can be used to group luminaires.

3.5. "Mode E: GC"

In "Mode E: GC" luminaire groups can be switched ON/OFF or dimmed up and down via single momentary-action switches and/or double momentary-action switches.

A system extension is typically done in this operating mode. If the lighting system is in programming mode, the momentary-action switches connected to the DALI XC in "GC" operating mode can be used to group luminaires. A description how to enable the programming mode and group luminaires can be found in the user manual of the DALI XC.

After the configuration, it is recommended to set the mode to "GC-A". Otherwise, saved scenes could be overwritten by other users.

3.6. "Mode F: PROG"

In "Mode F: PROG" the programming mode, which is used for commissioning or a system extension, can be started.

After the Start of the programming mode with "PROG", the operating mode is set to "GC" or "GC-A" to assign groups to luminaires in an installation. The operating mode "PROG" is used on an additionally connected DALI XC which is connected to an already existing DALI line. Therefore, it is possible to configure a DALI line, even if the installed DALI XCs in the DALI line are not accessible and the operating mode cannot be changed.

A detailed description for commissioning is available in the user manual of the DALI XC.


3.7. "Mode G: TuWh"

In "Mode E: TuWh" the intensity and colour temperature of Tunable White luminaires can be set via double momentary-action switches.
